

Register your LPG connection in PAHAL (Direct Benefit Transfer of LPG scheme) and get your subsidy amount directly in your bank account. This scheme will cover entire India from 1st January, 2015.

To join PAHAL, choose one:

If you have an Aadhaar card, then you need to submit your Aadhaar number to your bank and LPG distributor.

If you don't have an Aadhaar card, then you can submit your bank account details to your LPG distributor OR submit your 17-digit LPG ID number* to your bank*

If you do not have a bank account and/or an Aadhaar card, then you can go to the nearest centre to open a bank account and/or apply for Aadhaar card and then register for the scheme.



If you have already received the LPG subsidy in your bank account, you need not do anything.

- If you don't register in the same, then you will get subsidised LPG cylinder for a period of 3 months from the date of the launch of the scheme.
- After this 3-month period, LPG cylinders will be charged as per market rates for the next 3 months. You will get the subsidy admissible only if you register for the 'PAHAL' scheme within these 3 months.
- To check your registration status in the 'PAHAL' scheme, visit www.MyLPG.in and choose your gas company (Indane/Bharat Gas/HP Gas).
