## Abstract

Leave-Un-earned Leave on Medical certificate admissible to Government servants undergoing treatment for certain major ailments like Coronary surgery, Kidney transplantation, Retina transplantation - Availing of Un-earned Leave on Medical certificate without restriction - Orders issued.

## ORDER

As per the provision in the existing Tamilnadu Leave Rules, all approved probationers and permanant Government servants on Superior Service and also in Basic Service suffering from Tuberculosis, Cancer, Leprosy and Hansens diseases are eligible for Un-earned

Leave on Medical Certificate for 18 months in all at a time without any restriction prescribed in rule 15 of the said rules and also without reference to the Medical Board, if a certificate is received from a recognised institution where the Government servants are undergoing treatment.

- 2. A staff side member of Tamilnadu Civil Services Joint Council has requested that some of the major ailments like by-pass Coronary Surgery, Kidney transplantation and Retina transplantation which required treatment for longer periods may also be included in the Tamilnadu Leave Rules among with diseases like Tuberculosis, Leprasy, Cancer and Hansen's diseases so as to enable the Government Servants to avail Un-earned Leave on Medical certificate without restriction.
- The Government have examined the request carefully and they pass the following orders:-

Approved probationers and permanant Government servants, who undergo Coronary surgvery, Kidney transplantation or Retina transplantation, shall be permitted to avail Un-earned Leave on Medical Certificate without restriction of the period of leave based on total service stipulated in Rule 15 of the Tamilnadu Leave Rules, for the period for which a certificate is given by recognised institution, where the Government servants undergo treatment.

 Amendment to Tamilnadu Leave Rules will be issued separately.
