
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In continuation of this office letter cited, I am to state as a review of the orders issued on the subject it is felt that no clarification is required from Government regarding admissibility of allowances to retired Village Assistants on par with regular pensioners in view of the following reasons.

As per para 8(1) of Annexure to G.O (3D) NO.9 Rev Ser [7(1)] Dept dated 28/02/2006 special pension of Rs.150/p.m. with attendant benefits is admissible to Village Assistants who have completed 5 years of qualifying service along with DCRG. Attendant benefits mean DA, MA and IR.

Further in G.O. Ms. No. 105 Finance (PC) Dept dated 07/02/2006, Government have ordered that merger of 50% Dearness allowance with basic pay will also apply to Village Assistants in Revenue Department. Therefore, Village Assistant those who have retired prior to 01/01/2006; are entitled for Dearness Pension, Dearness Allowance [admissible in Basic Pension + Dearness Pension] and Medical Allowance and those who have retired after 01/01/2006 are entitled for Dearness Allowance and Medical Allowance. Hence you are requested to regulate the payments of allowances to Village Assistants as above.
