Sub: Public Services - Disciplinary Action - Orders administrative "Warning" - Question of entry in Personal Files - Instructions -Reiterated.

Ref: G.O. Ms. No. 1267, Public (Per-A) Dept. dt. 23.05.1967.

I am directed to state that in the Government Order cited, Government we issued instructions to the effect that where obviously an irregularity mmitted is considered serious, the correct position to take up is that least a 'Censure' should be awarded notwithstanding the regret expressed the Public Servant, and there should be no question of being carried as by any compassion or generacity in thinking that not even a censure ould be awarded'. However, it is noticed that certain disciplinary horities have not followed the above instructions issued to the eventuent Order cited. It is therefore clarified that in a case where ciplinary proceedings have been held under the relevant disciplinary and the charges have been proved, "Warning" or "Severe Warning" ruld not be issued as a result of such proceedings as warning is not alty classified under rule 8 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Services (Discipline Appeal) Rules. If it is found, as a result of the proceedings that some me is attached to the Government Servant and there is a need to

discipline him, then atleast the penalty of "Censure" should be imposed "Warning" or "Severe Warning" has not been classified as a recognishment and warning is "not an appointment of blame for the past only "an exhertation for the future". If, for any reason the disciplinary authority feels that the individual need not be punished in such cases disciplinary authority may take a decision "not to press the charges drop further action.

2. I am therefore, directed to request you to keep the instructions in mind while disposing of the disciplinary cases at your lead as the disciplinary authority. A copy of the Government Order cited is enclosed for ready reference and for being scrupulously followed.
