- Sub: Establishment -- Adi-Dravidar Welfare Department Fixation of pay of Tmt. J. Kalaiselvi, (Retd.)Typist Grade—I in the post of Special Grade Typist Clarification sought for Regarding.

I am to invite your attention to the references cited.

2) It is seen from the representation made by Tmt. J.Kalaiselvi, Retired Typist Grade—I that she has been appointed as Typist on 12—01—82 and awarded Special Grade in the post of Typist with effect from 12—01—2002. Further, it is seen that her pay has been fixed at Rs.10,470 + Grade Pay of Rs.4400 as per the proceedings dated: 30—01—12 and accordingly the Principal Accountant General has authorized her pension and pensionary benefits. But the Pay and Accounts Officer has returned the bill pointing out the clarification issued in the reference fourth cited and requested to obtain necessary further clarification from Government in this regard.

3) In this connection, I am to inform that in Government Order third cited among others, orders have been issued revising the scale of pay of the post of Typist from Rs.5200—20200 + Grade Pay Rs.2000 to Rs.5200—20200 + Grade Pay Rs.2400 notionally with effect from 1—1—2006 with monetary benefit from 01—02—11. Subsequently, in the reference fourth cited it was clarified that consequent on the above revision the posts of Typist and Typist Grade—I were placed equally in the scale of pay of Rs.5200—20200 + Grade Pay Rs.2400.

Hence, it was informed that consequent on the revision of scale of pay of Ordinary Grade Typist as Rs.5200-20200 + Grade Pay Rs.2400 (on par with Typist Grade—I) the Selection Grade scale of pay of Typist will be examined separately considering the fact that the post of Typist Grade—I is the promotion post for Typists opting to continue in the same line. In the instant case, it is seen that the individual has been awarded Special Grade in the post of Typist on 2002 itself. As such consequent on the revision of Ordinary Grade scale of pay of the post of Typist from Rs.5200-20200 + GP Rs.2000 to Rs.5200-20200 + GP Rs.2400 notionally with effect from 1-1--2006 with monetary benefit from 1-2-2011, the individual is entitled to fix her pay in the post of Special Grade Typist in the scale of pay of Rs.9300-34800 + GP Rs.4400 as indicated in SI.No.8 of Annexure-I to the Government Letter No. 63305 / Pay Cell / 10-1, Finance Department, dated: 08-11-2010. Therefore, there is no bar to fix the revised pay of the individual in the post of Special Grade Typist in the scale of pay of Rs.9300-34800 + GP Rs.4400 notionally with effect from 1--1--2006 with monetary benefit as ordered in the Government Order third cited. Further, the Accountant General in the reference fifth cited has also authorised the eligible grade pay of the individual and instructed to revise her pension / terminal benefits accordingly. Hence, I am directed to inform that the individual is entitled to fix her pay in the above Special Grade scale of pay and also eligible for the pensionery benefits as authorised by the Principal Accountant General. The Pay and Accounts Officer concerned is also instructed to admit the bill preferred in this regard, if otherwise, found in order.
