**ORDER:**

The following amendment is issued to Fundamental Rules.

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st January, 1974.

**Amendment**

In the said Fundamental Rules, under rule 26(a), in ruling (13), in item(i), (1) after 'Illustration-II' the following illustrations shall be aded, namely:

*“Illustration III”*

Date of accrual of last increment	= 1. 1. 80
Normal date of next increment	= 1. 1. 81
Extraordinary Leave without Allowance without Medical Certificate or reversion.	= 0. 4. 0
Date from which increment has to be sanctioned.	= <u>1. 5. 81</u>
Date of accrual of subsequent increment as per F.R. 26(a)	= 1. 4. 82

(2) at the end of item (i), the following shall be added, namely:-

“The punishment of stoppage of increment without cumulative effect does not postpone the future increments. The increment in such cases should be regulated as illustrated below:

***Illustration***

Date of accrual of last increment	= 1-4-80
Normal date of next increment	= 1-4-81
Stoppage of increment without cumulative effect for six months ordered in May, 1980.	= 0-6-0
Due date from which increment has to be sanctioned.	= <u>1-10-81</u>
Normal date of subsequent increment	= 1-4-82
