Abstract

Educational concessions to children of Government servants dying in harness - Rules for the grant of concessions - approved.

ORDER :

In the G.O. cited orders were issued on the recommendations of Second Pay Commission, sanctioning certain fee concessions including hostels charges to the children of Government servants dying in harness. The Government have considered the question of framing rules and evolving a procedure in consultation with the Director of Collegiate Education with a view to administer the scheme of grant of concession to such Government servants smoothly and efficiently. The Director of Collegiate Education, in consultation with other Heads of Departments has suggested draft rules for the purposes. The Government accept the draft rules suggested by the Director subject to certain modifications wherever necessary. The rules as approved are detailed in the annexure to this order.

2. All Heads of Departments and Departments of Secretariat are requested to ensure that the rules appended to this order are followed uniformly and strictly by their control.

ANNEXURE

1. Government in their order No. 816 Education dated 27-5-71 have accepted the recommendation of the Second Tamil Nadu Pay Commission and sanctioned the grant of Educational concession to the children of all Government servants of Tamil Nadu who die in harness.

2. This order comes into force with effect from 27-5-71.

- i) The concession will be granted with effect from the date next to the date of death of the Government servants when they die in harness.

- ii) The financial status of the bereaved family need not be taken as the criterion for eligibility for the educational concession to be sanctioned.

3. The children of deceased Government servants will be eligible for the remission of tuition fees beyond P.U.C. level as well as all the admissible items of special fees in Arts, Science and other Technical institutions till they obtain a degree or till marriage, in the case of female children, whichever is earlier.

4. (a) No book allowance, exemption from payment of examination fee etc. will be allowed.

(b) The reimbursement of cost of books, note books etc., where they have been specifically sanctioned to individual cases shall continue to be made by the respective heads of departments or by the authority sanctioning scholarship and this order does not supersede the previous orders issued in certain individual cases.

5. Hostel fees may also be paid to the children of the deceased Government servants staying in hostels or otherwise till they complete their existing course and can go to their native place to pursue their studies.

6. Hostel fees may also be paid in the case of children of deceased Government servants if there are no facilities in their native place to continue their study and if they are not getting any other residential scholarship. The native place in this connection refers to the place where the mother/guardian of the children of deceased Government servant resides.

(The term hostel occurring in the above rules may be taken to mean the hostels attached to the educational institutions where the student studies, the hostels under control of the Harijan and Tribal Welfare/Backward Classes Department or the private hostels recognised by the Social Welfare Department for purpose of grant of scholarships:)

7. If either the living husband or wife of the children gets remarried, the concession will be stopped with effect from the date of remarriage.

8. The educational concessions are extended to the children of the deceased Government Servant when they study in the evening colleges subject to the condition the concessions should be granted after ascertaining through the revenue authorities, the fact that the students are not employed anywhere.

9. (i) The concession should be granted in all Educational Institutions whether under public or private managements recognised by the Government.

(ii) The concessions will not be granted in case the children are admitted in fee levying schools.

(iii) In case the children of a Government servant who died in harness happened to study in recognised institutions OUTSIDE THE STATE, the application for the sanction of educational concession should be submitted to the Director of School Education or Medical Education or Technical Education, Tamil Nadu etc., as the case may be, if the student is studying in a school, or Arts or Science or Engineering or Medical College in that state, as the case may be, with the relevant fee receipts or vouchers in support of the hostel charges paid by the students, if any, duly attested by the Head of the institutions in that state and countersigned by the District Educational Officer or the Inspectress of Girls Schools concerned in that State. On receipt of the application with the fee receipts and vouchers duly countersigned by the authorities concerned the Director of School Education or Director of Collegiate Education, or Director of Medical Education, Director of Technical Education Tamil Nadu, as the case may be, shall sanction the Educational concessions.

The concessions will not be extended if the children happened to study in fee levying schools in other States. Remissions of tuition fee should be allowed only beyond P.U.C., level in such cases.

10. (i) The Director of Collegiate Education will arrange for the disbursement of hostel charges and award of concession to the pupils studying in the Government Colleges through the Departmental officers.

ii) Application for the payment of hostel charges in respect of the students studying in the aided colleges under the control of Director of Collegiate Education and in the Annamalai University has to be submitted to the Director of Collegiate Education, together with relevant vouchers (receipts) in support of the hostel charges paid by the student duly attested by the heads of institutions.

iii) The District Educational Officer will sanction concessions to the students studying in the primary and secondary schools for boys while the Inspectress of Girls' Schools will sanction the concession in respect of students studying in the secondary schools for girls.

iv) The Director of Technical Education Director of Medical Education, Director of Legal Studies, Director of Employment and Training, Director of Veterinary Education and Research and the Registrar, Agriculture university, Coimbatore and Registrar of other univer-

sities concerned are the authorities competent to sanction the concession in respect of the students studying in the institutions under their control.

v) In other cases, the concession will be granted by the competent authorities of the educational institutions who are empowered to grant fee concessions under the other schemes in force in the State.

11. The fee concession shall be withheld from a pupil if he/she has to attend the same course over and again on account of failure to pass in the examination in the first attempt in a particular class. The concession is withdrawn shall be revived when the pupil is subsequently promoted to the next higher class.

12. The children of the deceased Government servant may avail the above concession or any other concession/scholarship sanctioned by the Government of Tamil Nadu or the Government of India which whichever may be advantageous.

13. The fee income lost by the management on account of the grant of (tuition and special fees) concession will be made good in full and the same may be claimed in the Financial Statement of the institutions concerned for reimbursement.

14. The Heads of Departments or their subordinate officers empowered to sanction pension and death-cum-retirement gratuity to the deceased Government servants in question may issue certificate regarding the employee who expired while on duty as required in Appendix II or IV of these rules. In order to avoid the hardship to the family of the deceased Government Servants asking them to pay fees first and then get reimbursement later an entitlement card in the same way as is being done in respect of Harijan students, shall be issued to the students by the Heads of departments concerned under whom the deceased Government servants had worked, so as to enable the students to get admission in the educational institutions without any undue hardship. On production of the entitlement card the head of the institution may admit the student without insisting on the payment fees (tuition, special fees and hostel fees, if any) at the time of admission and these tuition fees, special fees, and hostel fees, if any, may be adjusted on receipt of orders of the competent authority sanctioning the educational concessions during the third term of the academic year.

15. The expenditure may be debited to the respective sub-head of account of the departments concerned, under the main head, "288 Social Security and Welfare".

16. The claim should be made in the prescribed applications forms, appended hereunder.
