Sub: Pension - Medical Allowance to the Government Servants and the employees of aided educational institutions and local bodies who are allowed to retire from service and who are getting provisional pension - Orders issued.

Read: From the Tamil Nadu State Retired Officials Association Madras Letter G.S. No.62/94, dated 8.12.1994.

In certain cases, the Government servants who are involved in the

disciplinary cases are permitted to retire from service on attaining the age of superannuation without prejudice to the disciplinary concerned. No medical allowance is being sanctioned on such provisional pension, though dearness allowance is being sanctioned on such provisional pension. The Tamil Nadu State Retired Officials Association, Madras in its letter read above has requested the Government to grant medical allowance of Rs.30/- p.m. to the Government servants who are allowed to retire from service and who are getting provisional pension.

- 2. The Government have carefully examined the question of allowing medical allowance to the Government servants and the employees of aided educational institutions / local bodies who are allowed to retire from service and who are getting provisional pension and decided to grant medical allowance at the admissible rates shall be sanctioned to the Government Servants and that employees of aided educational institutions and local bodies who are allowed to retire from service and who are getting provisional pension.
- 3. These orders shall be applicable in respect of provisional pension to be sanctioned on or after 1.4.95 irrespective of the date of retirement. In respect of provisional pension sanctioned prior to 1.4.95, medical allowance of Rs.30/- per mensem shall be allowed from 1.4.95.
