Conveyance Allowance - Conveyance Allowance paid to Blind and Orthopaedically handicapped State Government Employees - Maximum limit enhancement - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued sanctioning Conveyance Allowance to blind and orthopaedically handicapped employees at five percent of their basic pay subject to a maximum of Rs. 50/- p.m., subject to certain conditions laid down therein based on the recommendations of Fifth Tami! Nadu Pay Commission. In the Government Order second read above, the maximum limit of Conveyance Allowance was further enhanced from Rs. 50/- p.m. to Rs. 75/- p.m.

- 2. The Official Committee (1998) constituted in the Government Order third read above, to examine the extension of revised Central Scales of Pay to State Government Employees among other things, has recommended enhancement of the maximum limit of the above Conveyance Allowance from Rs. 75/- p.m. to Rs. 150/- p.m.
- 3. The Government has carefully examined the above recommendation of the Official Committee and decided to accept it. Accordingly, Government direct that the maximum limit of the Conveyance Allowance paid to blind and orthopaedically handicapped

State Government Employees be enhanced from Rs. 75/- to Rs. 150/p.m. (Rupees One hundred and Fifty only.) There shall be no change in
the existing conditions prescribed in the Government Order first read
above for sanction of this allowance.

- 4. These orders shall take effect from 1.9.98.
- 5. These orders shall apply to the Government Employees including Employees / Teachers working under Local Bodies and also to the Teaching and Non-Teaching employees in aided educational institutions.
